

Central Montcalm Public School
Board of Education
Meeting Minutes
July 30, 2014

The special meeting of the Board of Education was called to order by President Switzer in the High School Media Center on July 30, 2014 at 5:30 p.m.

Present: Switzer, Grossbauer, Barnwell, Giles, Rogers and Simpson.

Absent: Collins.

President Switzer welcomed those present to the meeting. Interim Superintendent Meinhardt gave some brief direction to the audience in regard to the interview process.

Mr. Peter Bush was interviewed for the position of Superintendent of Schools.

Mr. Andrew Shaw was interviewed for the position of Superintendent of Schools.

Dr. Charles Muncatchy was interviewed for the position of Superintendent of Schools.

The Board reviewed the strengths of each of the candidates. The Board encouraged audience participation.

Motion by Barnwell, supported by Grossbauer, that the Board of Education offer a contract to be our new Superintendent to Charles P. Muncatchy, pending successful completion of the professional conduct and criminal records check, specific contract terms to be negotiated. Roll call vote. Yeas: Rogers, Giles, Simpson, Switzer, Barnwell and Grossbauer. Nays: None. Motion carried.

President Switzer established an ad-hoc committee to review and recommend contract terms for employment of Charles P. Muncatchy. Motion by Rogers, supported by Barnwell, that Giles, Simpson and Grossbauer be authorized to negotiate contract terms for the employment of Charles P. Muncatchy as the Superintendent of Schools for the District. Roll call vote: Yeas: Rogers, Giles, Simpson, Switzer, Barnwell and Grossbauer. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Grossbauer departed the meeting to contact Dr. Muncatchy. Grossbauer returned to the table.

Motion by Simpson, supported by Rogers, that the Board of Education employ Charles P. Muncatchy as the new Superintendent of Central Montcalm Public School District, contract terms negotiable, pending successful completion of the professional conduct and criminal records check. Roll call vote: Yeas: Rogers, Giles, Simpson, Switzer, Barnwell and Grossbauer. Nays: None. Motion carried.

President Switzer thanked everyone in the audience, especially those who have participated in all previous special meetings. She also thanked the students, who took the time to participate in the hiring process. She thanked Mr. Grossbauer for all of his due diligence and many, many phone calls throughout the process.
